# Marshall named as director of MT Board of Crime Control

The Montana Board of Crime Control has announced the selection of Brooke Marshall as the new executive director.

Marshall, who has been court operations manager for Lane County Circuit Court in Oregon, will begin her duties on January 23.

As a pretrial services supervisor, Marshall helped secure a \$1.2 million federal grant to provide support services for victims of domestic violence in Oregon. Before joining Lane County Circuit Court, she worked as a personnel administrator, grant officer and a Safe Schools/Healthy Students director at Springfield, Oregon, Public Schools.

Marshall earned a bachelor's degree in political science from the University of Oregon in 1993 and obtained a Juris Doctorate from the University of Oregon School Of Law in 1998.

Mike Anderson, the chairman of the Board of Crime Control, said, "We're excited to have Ms. Marshall on board. Brooke will fit in well as MBCC's next executive director because she has the knowledge, skills, experience, passion and commitment to lead MBCC into the future."

The executive director is responsible for performing administrative and managerial duties related to developing and overseeing operations of the Crime Control Division, supporting the mission and activities of the Board of Crime Control, and determining, securing and allocating financial, human and other resources necessary to improve Montana's criminal and juvenile justice systems.

The executive director manages a staff of 16 and reports to the 18-member board, whose members are appointed by the governor.
