Bail Set For Man Facing 10th DUI Charge

Reginald Dawson Has 9 Prior DUI Convictions

OMAHA, Neb. -- A Sarpy County judge set bail at \$100,000 for Reginald Dawson.

The 51-year-old Bellevue resident was charged with his 10th DUI. He has prior convictions in Hawaii, Missouri, and Nebraska.

Officers stopped Dawson Friday night. He was parked in the middle of the road on Fort Crook. Officers said Dawson refused an alcohol breath test. Refusing a breath test is a felony under Nebraska law.

Dawson will be back in court for a preliminary hearing Feb. 27. If convicted, he faces up to 50 years if prison because of his prior history.
