

## Bail bondsman busted on child sex charges

WICHITA FALLS — Maxie (Maxx) Delano Green, 38, co-owner of A to Z Bail Bonds in Wichita Falls was arrested by Sgt. Simon Dwyer of Archer County Wednesday.

Dwyer, who also investigated the case, arrested Green just before noon on a felony warrant for aggravated sexual assault of a child.

Green's bond is set at \$500,000.

According to the warrant affidavit, Archer County has been investigating Green since the middle of August, and was finally able to get a warrant for his arrest.

The affidavit states that the victim is a 7 year-old child, and the alleged incidents happened on several different occasions.

After the victim was interviewed at Patsy's House, Wichita Falls Police were contacted by a Child Protective Services case worker.

During the interview detectives were told that the alleged incidents happened on "the farm."

Although Green owns A to Z Bail Bonds, his address is listed in the 6100 Block of Old Windthorst Road in Archer County.

Aggravated sexual assault is defined by the victim being younger than 14 years old and constitutes a first degree felony.

If convicted, the charges come with a sentence of 55 to 99 years in jail and mandatory lifetime registration as a sex offender with the National Sex Offender Registry.

Jack McGaughey, 97th District Attorney, will prosecute the case.
