Wildomar Mayor Claims Bail Bondsmen Broke Grandson's Nose, Tasered Daughter

The mayor of a Riverside County town, Marsha Swanson, claims they barged into her family's home Monday night.

RIVERSIDE (KTLA) -- The mayor of a Riverside County town said two bail bondsmen forced their way into her home, broke her grandson's nose and tasered her daughter in the stomach.

The Wildomar Mayor, Marsha Swanson, claims they barged into her family's home Monday night in search of a woman who is dating Swanson's grandson.

Sheriff's officials say the two bail bondsmen from Fausto's Bail Bonds in French Valley, Gausto Atilano, 48, and Bryan Stark, 46, had no legal authority to enter the property.

The 23-year-old girlfriend, Erica Lynch, was arrested last month on suspicion of receiving stolen property and released on five-thousand dollar bond.

While the company had revoked her bond, since Lynch doesn't live at the residence and wasn't a fugitive, they had no legal right to be there.

They took Lynch away to jail after a fight.

Authorities are seeking battery and trespassing charges against the two, but neither have been arrested.

Atilano said he was the one attacked and that they had the right to be there.

Swanson said her family didn't provoke them.

Swanson said the bail bondsmen took Lynch away from her home.
